



Continuation of Learning for Isolating Students Years PK – 6.

Saint Brigid's Primary School recognises the shifting and dynamic nature of COVID-19 for our community. In response to this, we are able to provide options which will ensure the continuation of learning for students in different isolating circumstances.

In the event a whole class or year level is required to isolate.



1. Your child will be marked as 'COVID Mandatory' on SEQTA and for the purpose of absentees.
2. The classroom teacher will implement the school's Remote Learning Plan for the isolating class.
3. The classroom teacher of the isolating class will communicate with families and students regarding learning provisions and expectations.
4. Teachers will monitor submitted work via work packs, See Saw or preferred learning platform used by the class.

In the event an individual student is required to isolate.



1. Your child will be marked as 'COVID Mandatory' on SEQTA and for the purpose of absentees.
2. The isolating student will be provided with a Remote Learning Work Pack and students and families can communicate with the classroom teacher via email.
3. As the majority of students will still be at school – in a face-to-face capacity – communication will not be provided for individual isolating students.
4. Teachers will initiate a check-in with the isolating student and/or their families, once over the course of the school week.
